The class arose out of the desire of Kittery officials to have their own emergency shelter available in the case of a major event, such as 2008's devastating ice storm. During the ice storm of December 12th 2008, Kittery residents had to be sent to shelters in Portsmouth or South Berwick.

The Town is reaching out to residents to help man the shelter. The Southern Maine Chapter of the Red Cross will train volunteers on a host of administrative and hands-on tasks involved in running a shelter. The class runs from 9:00am to 12:00 noon on Saturday Nov. 16th at the Community Center at 120 Rogers Road.
